Grade: 6 | Subject: QURAN (NATIVE)

Term 1

Tajweed & Quran:

- Surah At-Tariq (The Night Comer / The Morning Star)
- The meaning of Al-Isti'adha (seeking refuge with Allah — saying "A'udhu billahi min ash-shaytan ir-rajim")
- Situations of reciting quietly and aloud, and when to repeat Al-Isti'adha

- Surah Al-Buruj (The Constellations / The Great Stars) — verses 1–20
- Forms of combining Al-Isti'adha with Al-Basmalah at the beginning of Surahs or parts of Surahs
- Definition of An-Nun As-Sakinah (the silent ن) and At-Tanween (nunation)
- Surah Al-Inshiqaq (The Splitting Asunder) — verses 1–25
- The rule of Al-Idhhar Al-Halqi (clear pronunciation of noon sakinah or tanween when followed by throat letters)
- The rule of Al-Idgham An-Naqis (incomplete merging — merging without ghunnah)
- Surah Al-Mutaffifin (The Defrauders / Those Who Give Less) — verses 1–17

■ Term 2

- The rule of Al-Idgham Al-Kamil (complete merging — merging with ghunnah)
- Surah Al-Mutaffifin (The Defrauders / Those Who Give Less) — verses 18–35
- The rule of Al-Iqlab (changing / conversion — turning noon sakinah or tanween into a meem when followed by ب)

■ Term 3

- Surah Al-Infitar (The Shattering / The Cleaving)
- The rule of Al-Ikhfa' (hiding / concealment — of noon sakinah or tanween)
- Surah At-Takwir (The Overthrowing / The Folding Up) — verses 1–29 (complete Surah)
- The rule of Nun and Meem Mushaddadah (doubled ن and م with ghunnah of two counts)

Term 1

- Tafseer As-Sa'di: Surah Al-Fatihah (interpretation/explanation)
- Introduction to Tajweed (rules of Quranic recitation)
- Harakat & Tanween (short vowels and nunation)
- Madd & Leen Letters (elongation and soft vowel letters)
- Articulation points (Makharij al-Huruf — points of origin of letters)
- Shaddah (doubling/gemination) + Nun & Meem with Shaddah (obligatory ghunnah)

Term 2

- Tafseer: Surah Al-Mursalat (The Ones Sent Forth)
- Al-Waqf wa Al-Ibtida' (Stopping and Starting — rules of pausing and resuming in Quranic recitation)
- Tafseer: Surah Al-Qiyamah (The Resurrection)

Term 3

- **Tafseer:** Surah Al-Insan (Mankind / Man) — also known as Surah Ad-Dahr (The Time)
- **Nun Sakinah & Tanween:** The four rules:
 - Idhhar (clear pronunciation)
 - Idgham (merging)
 - Iqlab (changing/conversion)
 - Ikhfa' (hiding/concealment)

Term 1

Aqidah (Creed):

- The Pillars of Faith (Arkan al-Iman)

Tafseer (Quranic Interpretation):
